



Meeting Minutes for Raindrop Business Meeting dated 2-7-2026

Due to recurring connection issues at this meeting,
the minutes were taken via Zoom Ai.

Meeting summary

Quick recap

The meeting focused on a decorative painting class where students learned to create a winter scene featuring a log cabin and birch trees. The instructor demonstrated techniques for painting snow, logs, and trees using various paint colors and brushstrokes. Students were guided through the process of adding details to their pieces, including chimneys, branches, and fir trees. The instructor also discussed the history of the pattern and gave permission for students to use it for personal projects. At the end of the class, a raffle was held for students to win a free pattern packet from either Nancy Scott or Erica Joann's website, or a small primrose flower pattern.

Summary

Meeting Introductions and Bank Visit

Meeting Summary Continued

The meeting began with introductions from various members and locations. The group discussed technical issues with audio and video setup, which were eventually resolved. President, Georgia, announced that Terry and she had visited KeyBank to have Terry added as an officer, though the bank manager was not present.

Creative Sharing and Life Balance

The meeting experienced technical difficulties due to internet connectivity issues, with Georgia confirming the problem and promising to update when ready. The group discussed the challenges of balancing multiple responsibilities, with Beckie and others reflecting on how their lives have been shaped by overcommitment and the need for self-care.

Class Adaptations and Access Updates

The group discussed technical difficulties with connecting a laptop to a TV for a class, with Georgia explaining they had to use the TV as a monitor instead. They confirmed that the class would proceed online, with Bobbie teaching and being visible to students through Zoom. The group also mentioned that Lucy Gertcher's class would be held in April.

Class Activity and Teaching Changes

The meeting began with a discussion about conducting a secret sister activity at lunch. Bobbie inquired about Tracy Moreau's teaching status, and it was revealed that she had to bow out due to a chronic illness, with Shannon Miller taking her place. Shannon will have her Seminar here May 22nd and 23rd. The cost for the seminar will be \$60 per day for members. A choice of taking one or both is optional.

Sandy McTier will be here September 25th and 26th. \$60 is also the cost for members, A continental breakfast and lunch will be included in the \$60.

Judy expressed gratitude for receiving necessary materials in time. The group encountered technical difficulties connecting to Zoom, which were eventually resolved for the Zoom students only but not the in-house students. The conversation ended with Bobbie preparing to start the class session.

Log Cabin Painting Techniques

The instructor, Bobbie Redington, demonstrated techniques for painting a log cabin scene, starting with a white side load shading for the background sky and applying thin layers of white paint for the roof snow. She showed how to base coat the birch tree trunks with burlap color and explained the process of painting the cabin walls with raw sienna, followed by espresso floating underneath the roofline. The instructor emphasized keeping lines straight and maintaining distinct stops and starts

when painting the cabin walls to ensure accuracy. She continued with Winter scene painting techniques.







EASTER CAKE MIX BAR RECIPE



These easy and delicious Easter Cake Mix Bars only require 6 ingredients and are the perfect bar to serve up for Easter dessert. The bars are super soft and the topping gives a fun chewy crunch to every bite.



INGREDIENTS

- 15.25 ounce box yellow cake mix
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter melted
- 1 large egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups fruity mini marshmallows
plain mini marshmallows work too
- 1/2 cup Easter M&M's

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Line the bottom of a 7×11-inch baking pan with parchment paper. Spray the parchment paper and sides with nonstick cooking spray.
2. In a large bowl, add cake mix, melted butter, egg, and vanilla extract. Beat with a hand mixer on medium speed until combined.
3. Evenly press the batter into the bottom of the prepared baking pan.
4. Place in the preheated oven for 18 to 23 minutes. The edges will be golden brown and when placing a toothpick into the center of the bar, it should come out clean or with moist crumbs.
5. Sprinkle the marshmallows and then the M&M's on top of the bars making sure evenly distribute them both.
6. Place the bars back in the oven for 2 to 3 minutes. The shells of the M&M's will crack slightly and the marshmallows will melt into each other.
7. Remove from the oven and let the bars cool completely.
8. Using a sharp knife, cut into 12 bars to serve. The knife may stick to the marshmallows. To avoid this as much as possible, spray your knife with a little nonstick cooking spray or run very hot water over the knife and wipe it clean before making each cut.
9. Store in an airtight container at room temperature.


