Painter's Nest Gourd Birdhouse

By Liz Ezell

Supplies:

- Americana Paints: Light Buttermilk, Charcoal, Honey Brown, Gray, Light Cinnamon, Golden Straw, Tomato Red, Titanium White, Avocado, Sapphire, Dusty Rose
- Brushes: JS Liner, ¾" angle brush, scruffy or small deerfoot brush

Instructions:

- Base gourd with 2-3 coats of Light Buttermilk, then apply pattern with graphite paper.
- Base roof with Dusty Rose and rough in shingle pattern lightly with a pencil.

Shingles

Shade lightly with Blue Grey Mist:

Left side of each house shingle (not roof shingles)

The bottom of each house shingle (not roof shingles) using a "wiggly" motion to depict a rough surface

Under the sign

Around both windows and the door

Shade the right side of each roof shingle with Light Cinnamon

Shade the bottom of each roof shingle using the "wiggly" motion

Sign

Base oval sign in Titanium White
Brush handle is tomato red. Also outline the sign with liner of tomato red after the white has dried.

Ferrell is gray, shaded on the bottom with Charcoal

Lettering is lined with charcoal. Connect the brush to the oval sign with charcoal liner.

Also shade under the oval sign.

Windows

Shade around the windows with charcoal (top and bottom and outside of the shutters, not between the shutters and the window)

Shade the right side of the brush jar with honey brown

Paint the brush handles with Light Cinnamon, the Ferrell with gray and the bristles with



Golden Straw (both the brush jar and the easel are “suggestions” and do not need to be exact

Shade the top and bottom of the easel with gray

Paint the easel gray

Shade around the window with Charcoal, using a mop to soften the center if necessary so the easel and the brush jar are still visible

Shade around the inside edges of the shutters with Honey Brown

Line around the windows and “cross” the center of each window with liner of Titanium White

Make “Dolly Parton” hearts in the center of each shutter with Tomato Red.

Make little strokes on each side of each heart with Avocado

Door

Shade on the right side of each plank with Honey Brown

Shade the sides and bottom with Honey Brown

Paint the palette Titanium Wt. and around the top and sides (NOT BOTTOM) of the door with liner in Titanium Wt.

Shade around the palette lightly with Honey Brown. Deepen lightly with Charcoal if necessary.

Paint the thumb hole of the palette, the door knob and the “OPEN” lettering with Charcoal

Pools of palette paint are tomato red, avocado, golden straw and sapphire

Base the step gray and shade the bottom and right side with Charcoal.

Window Boxes

Base gray

Shade around the outside (left, right and beneath) with Charcoal

Foliage

Pounce in greenery with a Deerfoot or scruffy brush with Avocado. Highlight lightly by pouncing a mix of avocado and Titanium White.

Flowers in the box are pounced in lightly with Tomato Red and are highlighted lightly with Titanium Wt

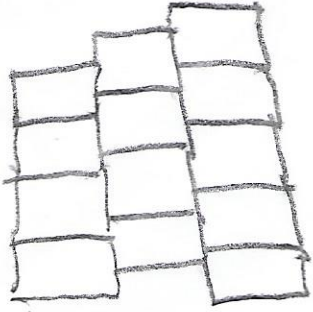
Flowers around the base of the house are dots of Sapphire Blue, with highlights of a mix of blue and white

Dab in random flowers with Golden Straw and/or White for accent.

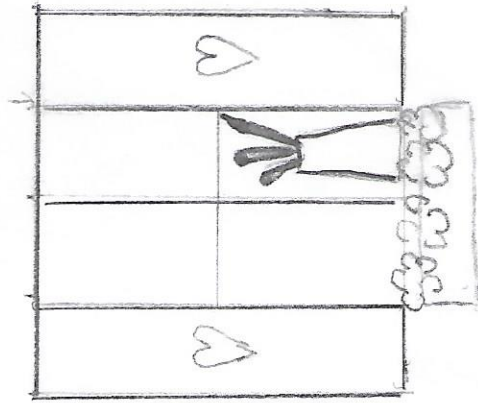
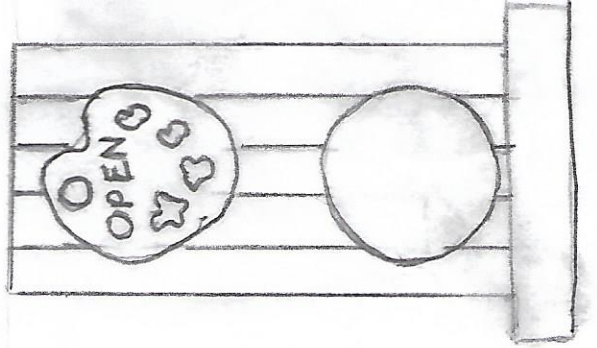
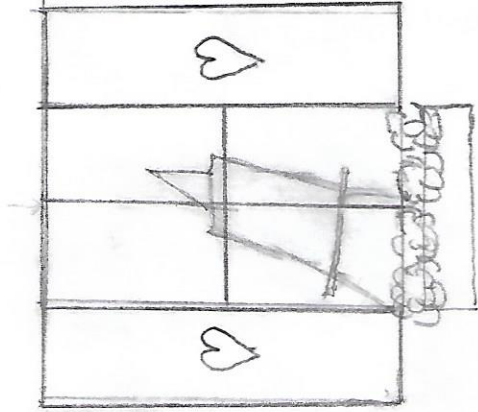
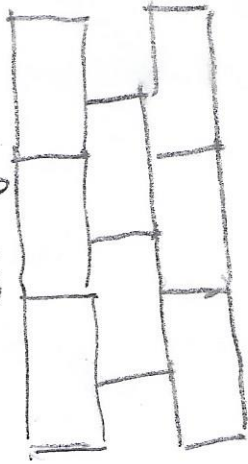
Varnish with a product rated for outdoor use if you intend to hang this outside. Enjoy!!

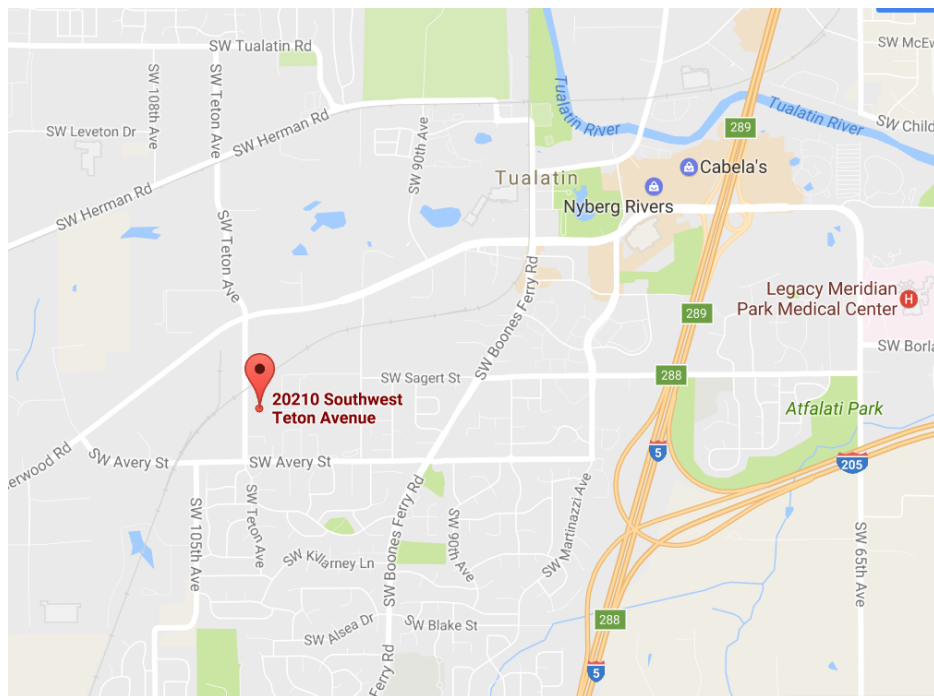
