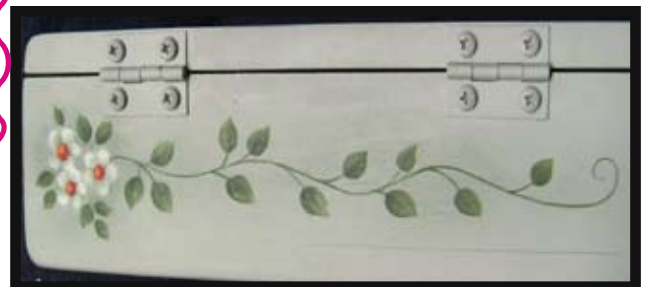

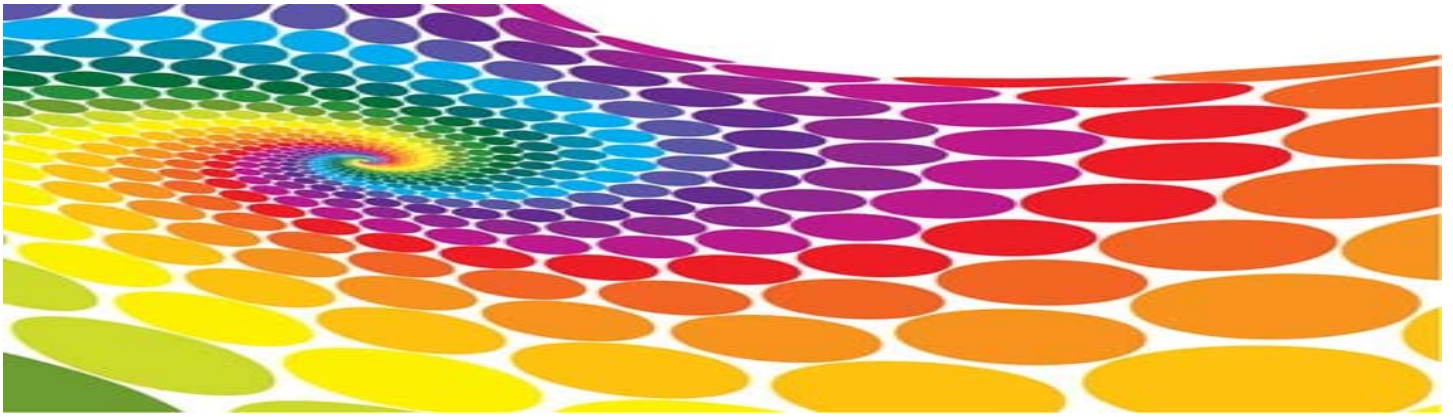

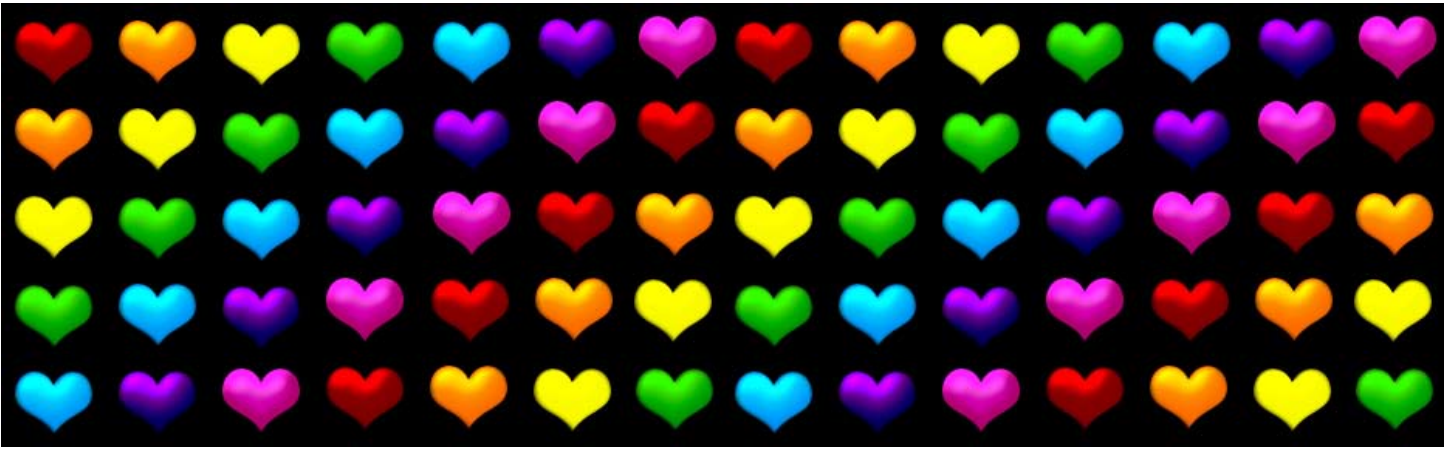

Items Needed: The only thing the shelter does not need is used women's clothing because they are associated with The Salvation Army and can get what they need there. They do not have the storage space for alot of clothes.

What they need most is consumable items just like we would all use up monthly. The list includes paper towels, toilet paper, kleenex, baby items, deodorant, razors, laundry soap, shampoos and conditioners (also for African American), hand sanitizers, kitchen cleaners, canned meats, non-perishable foods, gift certificates, bus passes, pillow cases, towels and hand cloths, extra long twin sheets, sleeping bags, air mattresses, copy paper, pens and composition notebooks, 2011 daily planners, tampons, plastic silverware, paper plates and bowls, alarm clocks, diapers (especially sizes 5 & 6), olive oil, butter, frozen foods, coffee, canned tomatoes, parmesan cheese, fresh foods, milk, meat, toys, flashlights, backpacks for adults, umbrellas, bras and underwear of all sizes. Of course, cash is always appreciated.

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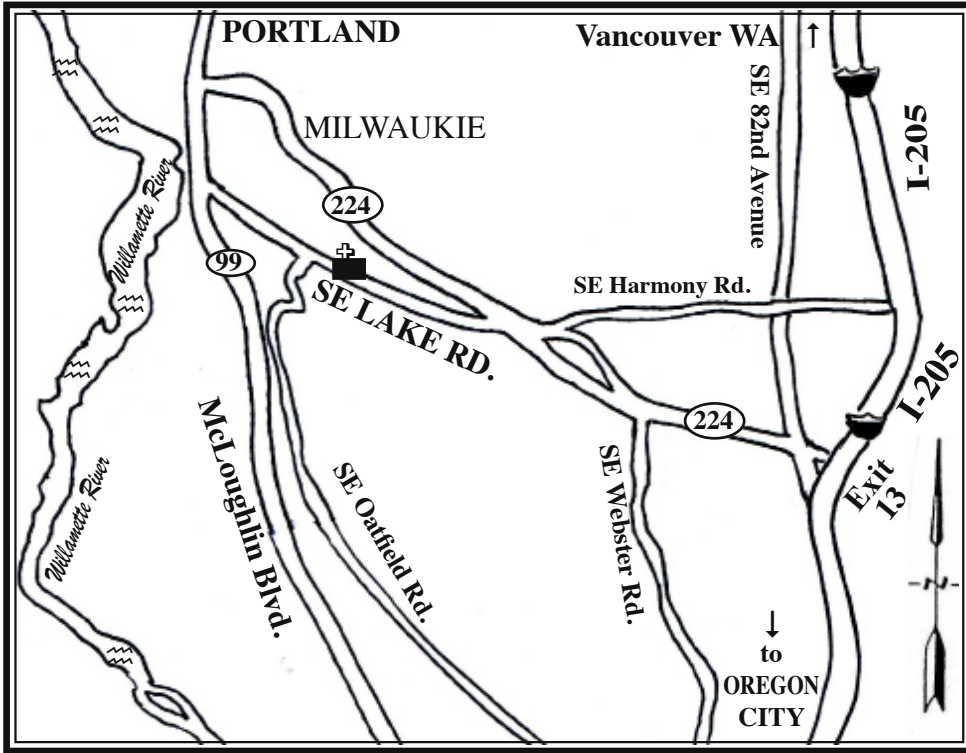

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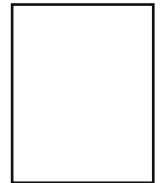
